BURTON ROAD, KINGSTON UPON THAMES TEMPORARY CLOSURE

The Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames, being the traffic authority for Burton Road, in the said borough, **HEREBY GIVES NOTICE THAT**, it is satisfied that temporary restrictions should be imposed on the said road for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event, "Street Party" therein:

1. This order shall come into operation on Saturday 19 May 2018, remaining in force for that day only, and may be cited as the 'Burton Road 2018 Street Party' Temporary Traffic Notice.
2. No person shall, until the said event has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain at rest in:
 - Burton Road from the junction of Acre Road to the junction of Richmond Park Road.
3. The restrictions specified in Article 2 of this Order shall apply only during the period specified and during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and general Directions 2002.
4. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent the statutory powers and duties of the local authority, fire brigade, police or ambulance services.
5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable or a traffic warden in uniform.
6. While the prohibition specified in paragraph 2 above applies, access to premises on or adjacent to the effected roads shall be maintained insofar as is reasonable without interference with execution of the said event.
